

ICAC-CERCA launches an open course to train in Archaeology Research Data Management

Why bother preparing research data management?

The **Documentation Centre, Library, and Open Science Service** of the ICAC-CERCA publishes **“Research Data Management Training in Archaeology”**, a self-study course in research data management for the research community; especially aimed at phd researchers.

The course is **available openly through the Canvas platform** (an open-source virtual learning platform) and is structured into four successive modules. Each module contains informative material, exercises, and self-assessment tests to reinforce and apply the knowledge acquired.

Although the course is aimed at PhD researchers, it can also be useful for the research community and master's students.

The course is available in **Catalan** and **English**. Also, you can download the materials directly from the **RECERCAT repository**.
